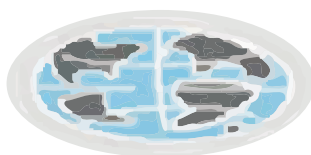

Monterrey, the state capital of Nuevo Leon, is a beautiful, modern metropolis that has evolved into a world-class destination with colonial-era attractions and a vibrant cultural scene. Serrated mountain peaks surround the city, making for a rather striking backdrop for its fine hotels, stately museums, bold modern architecture and abundant restaurants. Monterrey displays a distinct norteco culture, and has taken great strides to showcase its historic treasures. While it maintains its role as one of the country's most important industrial centers, an ambitious urban renewal effort has remodeled much of the downtown area.
